MARKER SIZE

Single Lot-Old Section	12" x 24" to 18" x 36"
Single Lot-New Section	16" X 28"
Dual Lot-Double Depth	16" X 28"
Ground Cremation Lot	8" X 11"
Columbarium Hexagon	5" X 7"

- Markers must be made of solid industry standard granite. Bronze veteran markers will be accepted but they must be U.S. standard bronze and must be set in concrete or mounted on solid industry standard granite and have a lawn mower proof edge.
- All markers will be set or removed by Temecula Public Cemetery District personnel only.
- Hexagon Wall markers must be purchased through Sun City Granite, no other markers will be accepted.
- Concrete borders are at the discretion of the certificate holder but are not required by TPCD.
- Lawn mower proof or beveled edge is required for all in ground markers
- Only one marker allowed per lot.

Temecula Public Cemetery District is not responsible for any damage to markers or photographs on markers. We will use as much caution as possibly to protect your marker, but scratches, fading, slippage or other damages are not the responsibility of the Temecula Public Cemetery District.
